# Financials (Deepta)

- Classroom grants is reasonably on par with last year
- Need to investigate why no costs for last year's Grandpal's Day
  - o Action Item: Deepta to investigate costs of Grandpal's Day from last year
    - Follow up yes there were costs related to GrandPal's Day last year...last year
      the finances were calculated as income net expenses and this year we are
      showing income and expenses separately for greater transparency
- Upcoming events are in the process of being planned (Music night) or postponed (hot dog night, graduation)
  - o Follow Up some events are being posted online, while others are being postponed
    - Music Night online
    - Hot Dog Night postponed until we can get together...note that the funds for HDN are solely for the purpose of a potential shortfall since HDN is not a fundraising event
    - Graduation there is an annual budget of \$2200 for graduation each year...this
      year the funds will be split between spring activities and a postponed event
      when the graduate families are able to gather in-person
- Surplus Funds
  - We will want to look at remaining funds for the year and earmark their use
    - Follow Up there are little remaining funds beyond what is earmarked for endof year activities + cost of social worker that is being paid by PA
  - Question/comments:
    - If we have a surplus based on projection re: rest of the year I think it would be important to give cost savings/surplus back to parents for at least two reasons:
      - (1) don't want to go into new fiscal year with a large balance, not best practice;
      - (2) any costs savings should be passed on
  - o Is it possible to provide refunds for any unused PA funds?
    - Follow up No, we cannot give refunds because tax receipts have been issued and the benefit to parents is therefore realized

#### Teacher Gifts

### Increased costs from last year

- Extra lice check this year
  - This is offset by the lack of lice check in the spring term
- Funds put toward schoolyard improvements (North side of school) (School Yard Improvements line. NOTE - Those funds were from the previous school year.

#### Patrick Harvie:

- Need to reinvest GICs. We were meeting with Scotia, just before C19 hit.
- o The PH income will likely go to around \$14000 once add'l funds received.
- Netted out approx. \$9-10,000 on Patrick Harvie.

### • Library Fund:

- Thanks to Shone, Krista and Shami who (with others) did a great job of purchasing baskets and items for raffles.
- We discovered at the beginning of the school year that Krista had a lot of money available to spend on books and speakers. She spent more this year.

### Social worker

- Estimated costs of social worker to end of school year will be about \$11,000. We are thinking to increase that for next year.
- Reminder the PA will not be funding classroom grants out of the general account in 2020-21, but instead be funding the social worker for next school year

### Graduation

- Schools like UCC/BSS have identified Thanksgiving weekend as graduation time. They'll
  do virtual until then. We'd love for there to be a reception, which is what the PA helps
  with. We need to decide.
  - Follow up confirmed that this year's grade 6 class will go virtual in the spring and reconvene when it is safe to do so in person – funds will be held by the PA until then

### Fundraising

- PA Fundraising Need to consider fundraising in the Fall, sensitivities, different modalities
  - PA is looking to fundraise without families having to spend extra money in order to reduce fees / donation amounts collected in the fall...looking towards a campaign in the summer months
- o Longer term fundraising for Endowment Fund -
